Thanks to our clinical affiliation with Saint Luke's Health System, you can receive advanced cancer care closer to home. Patients' care is coordinated by our team of board-certified medical oncologists and nurse navigator who are responsible for each patient's care from the moment of diagnosis and throughout the course of treatment.

Our team stays in contact with the patient and the primary care provider each step of the way to ensure a smooth transition of care. Our nurse navigator serves as a contact and care coordinator to assist throughout the patient's journey.

Medical oncologists work with each patient to:

- Explain the cancer diagnosis and stage
- Discuss all available treatment options and recommend the best course of treatment
- Help manage cancer- or treatment-related pain and side effects to ensure patients experience the best quality of life possible during treatment

Advanced oncology care closer to home.

The Saint Luke's Cancer Institute medical oncologists, who have expertise in treating a wide range of cancers, work with SLCI's integrated, multidisciplinary care team which includes radiation oncologists, surgeons, pathologists, nurses, pharmacists, social workers, dietitians, and counselors. This team meets weekly to review cases and tailor treatments to ensure the best possible outcome for our patients. Should patients need advanced treatment or a level of care not available in Warrensburg, patients will have access to Saint Luke's Cancer Institute's services at Saint Luke's East Hospital in Lee's Summit and Saint Luke's Hospital in Kansas City.
