

WMMC VISITOR RESTRICTIONS

As a patient and family-centered hospital, we understand visitors play an important role in patients' healing and recovery. Due to COVID-19, WMMC has restricted visitor access to protect our team and your loved ones.

Visitors will be required to follow strict hand hygiene procedures and wear a mask.

HOSPITAL VISITS

- Visitor hours are 8:30 a.m. to 8:30 p.m.
- Two visitors at a time are allowed per patient.
- Masks are required for all visitors.
- COVID-19 patients will not be allowed any visitors.
- Masks are not required for visitors under age 2.
- Emergency patients may have one visitor at a time. We have no visiting hour restrictions for emergency patients.
- Due to limited lobby space and social distancing, additional Emergency Department visitors may be asked to remain in their cars.
- Obstetric patients may have two primary support people at any time while laboring.
- One additional visitor may be at the bedside during regular visiting hours after delivery. COVID-19 OB patients will be allowed one support person at any time.
- Sibling visitation is open for obstetrics patients from 5 – 7 pm daily.

CLINIC VISITS

- One designated person will be allowed per patient.
